Dear Parents / Guardians,

Vigilance against Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease (HFMD)

I would like to draw your attention to the recent increase in the activities of hand, foot and mouth disease (HFMD) in class 2H and urge parents to be vigilant against the diseases.

Maintaining good personal and environmental hygiene is the most important measure to prevent HFMD. Alcohol-based handrub should not substitute hand hygiene with liquid soap and water, as alcohol does not effectively kill some viruses causing HHMD. Parents are recommended to take the following measures:

1. Keep your child at home for rest when he/she develop fever or rash.
2. Child who develop symptoms suggestive of HFMD should seek medical advice promptly.
3. Child with HFMD should be excluded form school until fever has subsided and all the vesicles have dried and crusted.
